

# FINAL CALL FOR PAPERS

The 5<sup>th</sup> international conference on ITS Telecommunications (ITST 2005) will be held in Brest on 27–28–29 June, 2005. After four previous editions in Asia, the conference is taking place for the first time in Europe. It will bring together engineers and scientists in the emerging field of Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS), and topics not only in ITS but also in the wider field of radiocommunications will be presented, given the close link between the two.

The conference will provide a forum within the international scientific and engineering community for the exchange of ideas, information and latest results in telecommunications and ITS applications.

There will be both oral and poster sessions, with contributed and invited papers, covering the topics of transportation policy, economics and standards, as well as infrastructures, research results, technologies and applications. Technical exhibitions and demonstrations will be held at the congress center and technical visits will also be proposed.



## **GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION**

Prospective authors are invited to submit electronically via the conference web site (<u>http://conferences.enst-bretagne.fr/itst2005</u>) a 2-page summary of their work in .pdf format before **15 February 2005**, including figures in black and white. The cover page must include: the title of the paper, authors' names and affiliations, contact author's name and address (both postal and electronic), keywords and submission area (from the list of relevant areas of interest). A reprint of the accepted papers (for which at least one author is registered for ITST 2005 by 30 April, 2005) will be handed out to participants on the opening day. The conference proceedings will also be distributed on CD-ROM. Detailed instructions for preparing the final papers will be given on the web site.

Please notice that there will be a best student paper award.
