Presentation

The 5th international conference on ITS Telecommunications (ITST 2005) will be held in Brest on 27–28–29 June, 2005.

After four previous editions in Asia, the conference is taking place for the first time in Europe. It will bring together engineers and scientists in the emerging field of Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS), and topics not only in ITS but also in the wider field of radiocommunications will be presented, given the close link between the two.

The conference will provide a forum within the international scientific and engineering community for the exchange of ideas, information and latest results in telecommunications and ITS applications.

There will be both oral and poster sessions, covering the topics of transportation, policy, economics and standards, as well as infrastructures, research results, technologies and applications. Technical exhibitions and demonstrations will be held inside and outside the congress center. Technical visits will also be proposed.

This conference will provide an opportunity for industrialists and suppliers to show the international community involved in ITS how future intelligent systems will help users and how they will be integrated into tomorrow's transportation systems. Laboratories will also be able to present their research via demonstrations during the exhibition.

2.1- Main dates

Exhibition dates

From Monday 27 to Wednesday 29 June, 2005.
 Conference opens on Monday 27 June at 10.00 am.
 Conference closes on Wednesday 29 June at 1.30 pm.

Access:

FORUM entrance at *Le Quartz* Congress Center, rue du Château.

Exhibitors are allowed to park in front of the FORUM entrance while unloading their exhibition material. Their vehicle must be moved immediately once the material has been unloaded.

Set-up

Exhibitors will have access to their stand on Sunday 26 June, 2005 from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm.

Opening times during the conference

Exhibitors: from 8:00 am to 6:30 pm

Disassembly

For stands and car exhibitions outside: Wednesday 29 June 2005 from 1:30 pm to 5:00 pm .

Restoration of premises

Exhibitors must restore their site to its original condition, removing all elements of their stand. Damage noted during the set-up or disassembly of stands will be invoiced to the exhibitor responsible for it (the exhibitor is liable for his subcontractors). Equipped stands should be returned in the same condition as upon delivery to the exhibitor.

2.2- Technical data

2.3- Safety

Equipping of stands

Stand framework and partitioning

The following materials can be used to build the stand framework:

- All materials classified at least M3 (moderately flammable).

Covering material

Coverings (natural textiles or plastic) classified M0, M1, M2 or M3 (from incombustible to moderately flammable) can be used, and attached using staples.

Various coverings (cloth, paper, plastic sheeting) which are moderately to easily flammable and which are very thin (maximum 1 mm) must be thoroughly glued onto M0, M1, M2 or M3 backing material.

In every case, the following materials are prohibited:

- Soft fibreboard,
- Boards, panels, or expanded plastic or foam materials which are not classified at least M3.

Insurance

LE QUARTZ disclaims any and all liability for any physical or material damage which could be caused when manipulating any material or equipment either belonging to or rented by the exhibitor for this event.

In this respect, each exhibitor undertakes to provide for a clause in his insurance contract waiving any and all recourse against LE QUARTZ.

Exhibitors should also take out an insurance policy giving them coverage for the risks mentioned above and for any personal liability they may incur over the duration of the exhibition, storage, setting up, disassembling and reshipping included.

LE QUARTZ may require the insurance certificate to be shown.

Empty packaging

All empty packaging must be removed immediately. It is forbidden to obstruct the stands and safety aisles with packaging which could create additional combustion in the case of fire. If you have storage problems, an area will be made available to you.

Decorative panels at back of stand, racks, counters, shelving

Any material rated at least M2 may be used to build decorative panels, racks, counters, shelving, etc.

Use of materials made of methyl methacrylate (Plexiglas type) is FORBIDDEN.

Decorative elements (floating elements)

Floating elements used to decorate or dress the stand (billboards larger than 0.50m², garlands, lightweight decorative items, etc.) must be made of M0 or M1 materials, or be made fireproof by fire retardant treatment.

Floral decoration

Use of artificial plants and flowers made of plastic or paper is LIMITED. Only those artificial plants and flowers made of fire-retardant treated fabrics (at least M2 fire rating) will be allowed.

Fire-proofing

For any use of materials mentioned above, a Fire Rating certificate must be supplied to the organizer's technical manager.

Special clause

It is strictly prohibited to drill, screw or staple anything onto the stand partitions.

To hang your panels or any other display, you may use picture rails, chains or "Blu-Tack"[®] (adhesive)
